Cold Weather Tips

Some of the best ways to combat frozen water lines is to do exactly what our “freeze warning” signs espouse: Unhook water hoses, open cabinet doors in the kitchen and bath sinks, keep all your interior bedroom and bathroom doors open, Change your HVAC filter regularly, keep your thermostat turned to 73 or lower, make sure your doors and windows are closed tightly and weather strip is in good condition.

Don't forget our heat and air machines are geo-thermal they are just a bit different than your run of the mill A/C units. Like other “heat pumps” our units actually pull heat from the environment. Ours, unlike most also are able to pull heat from the water which circulates thru them.

You can help us by allowing your machine to shut off periodically (keep the thermostat set at 73 or below) and change your filter regularly. Be sure, if we haven't already picked up a window A/C unit, to call us and let us take it out of the window, take it to the shop and service it for next year. You'd be surprised how much drafty, cold air comes in around a window air conditioner.

If you are going to be gone for a few days, DO NOT set your thermostat down to 50. One of the neat things about a geo-thermal HVAC system is that they are very economical to run and leaving the thermostat at 65 to 70 or so will help ensure your water lines do not freeze, burst, flood your house. Keep your doors and windows shut tightly as much as possible. Someone is saying “well duh...” You'd be surprised how many folks stand in an open door way and chat with the neighbor or just wait for the pet to do its business. Same for windows, especially in the bathroom. We are likely to have more cold weather coming. Be prepared, be sensible and be WARM. Calls us if we can help.
