RECIPE CORNER

Mardi Gras Jambalaya

Ingredients

- 1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breast, Cut into 1" cubes
- 1 pound smoked turkey sausage or andouille sausage, Cut into 1" slices
- 1/2 pound shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 1 (28 oz) can crushed tomatoes, undrained
- 1 3/4 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup uncooked rice (long or whole grain)
- 1/2 cup dry white wine
- 2 green or red bell peppers, coarsely chopped
- 1 large onion, coarsely chopped
- 4 tsp Creole seasoning
- 1 tsp garlic powder

Directions

- 1. In a soup pot over medium heat, combine all ingredients, mix well.
- Cover and cook for 15 minutes.
- 3. Reduce heat to low and simmer for 30-35 minutes. or until rice is cooked.
- 4. Enjoy!
